Coronavirus Mass Attendance Guidelines

The requirement to attend weekend Mass is still suspended—so you do not have to attend.

People 65 & over should stay home.

People with health conditions should stay home (high blood pressure, chronic lung disease, diabetes, severe obesity, asthma, those undergoing chemotherapy to name a few causes to stay home).

We will continue to broadcast weekend Masses on our Website, Facebook, YouTube Channel, and Parish App.

If you come to church:

Please wear a facemask in church.

Social distancing—six feet or more—is required. Space will be marked off between pews and between people. People who live together can sit together. If too many people show up, we may have to restrict attendance. There should not be any social gathering inside or outside of church. If you have pocket sized hand sanitizer, please bring it.

For receiving Holy Communion:

You are not obligated to receive Communion.

If you do receive be sure to keep at least six feet apart, lower your facemask only to receive. Speak softly when you say "Amen." If you come forward for a blessing instead of communion, it will be an "at-a-distance" blessing—a "no-touch" blessing. We cannot offer Communion from the cup at present.
