

#### Ash Wednesday Wednesday, February 17, 2021

Mass with the distribution of ashes 12:10 pm Mass at St. Joseph Church 5:30 pm Mass at St. Anthony Church

Ashes this year will be distributed by sprinkling them on each person's head. Following is a brief explanation of this practice: Sprinkling ashes on the top of the head recalls the biblical practice of putting on "sackcloth and ashes" as an act of penance. For example, we read in the Book of Nehemiah: "On the twenty fourth day of this month, the Israelites gathered together while fasting and wearing sackcloth, their heads covered with dust" (Neh 9:1). While the custom in the USA has been to mark the forehead with a cross, sprinkling the ashes on the head remains the custom in other parts of the world such as Spain and Italy.

However the ashes are received, the interior repentance expressed by this exterior act is at the heart of the action.

#### Live the Liturgy ~ Inspiration for the Week

"Repent, and believe in the gospel." Some type of honest and sincere repentance is necessary for any type of authentic growth and maturity. We have to come to the realization, unless we are happy wallowing in immaturity and superficiality, that the way we have been doing things is not the best or the healthiest. There isn't a human being alive who hasn't acted foolishly or erratically at the cost of almost losing a treasured relationship. "Why did I act that way?" is a question we often ponder after some reflection and enlightenment. Faith works the same way. Stumbling through life and bumping up against meaninglessness, a person can begin to see that something significant is missing. They see that there is merit to a relationship with God and an embrace of faith. Before these can take root, sincere sorrow for past wrong doing, missed opportunities, errors in judgment, and short sightedness is necessary. Repentance is necessary. Then having realized that we were walking in darkness, we can rejoice that by God's grace we now see the light. ©LPi

Our responsorial psalm for this weekend is, "Teach me your ways, O Lord."


When I first read this, it reminded me of our theme for this year that is written above.





# Serving the Church for over 160 years! Saint Meinrad

Saint Meinrad's commitment to priestly formation began in 1857. Over the intervening years, more than 4,300 alumni have become priests. Currently, more than 1,500 Saint Meinrad alumni serve the Church as priests throughout the world.

In addition, nearly 7,000 lay alumni are serving the Church and society in many different vocations. Men and women in lay ministry, both professional and volunteer, have benefited from receiving a quality education at Saint Meinrad.

Saint Meinrad has served the needs of the Diocese of Evansville for many years. There are 49 active and retired priests of the diocese (including Bishop Siegel and Bishop Emeritus Gettelfinger), 52 permanent deacons, 15 religious and 345 lay people who are alumni of Saint Meinrad.

Saint Meinrad began the 2019-20 school year with an enrollment of 122 seminarians representing 27 dioceses and 10 religious communities. The Diocese of Evansville currently has 6 seminarians studying at Saint Meinrad.

The Seminary and School of Theology offers several programs to meet the ministerial needs of the Church. Men preparing for the priesthood pursue the Master of Divinity degree and Master of Arts (Catholic Philosophical Studies).


Men and women who are seeking to serve the Church as lay ministers study for the Master of Arts (Theology). Saint Meinrad also provides a Permanent Deacon Formation Program to 8 dioceses, and offers year-round retreats for those looking for spiritual nourishment.

Each summer, hundreds of high school and college youth participate in the "One Bread, One Cup" conferences. They learn more about their Catholic faith and develop skills they can use when they return to their home parishes.

Today the monastic community of about 80 priests and brothers serves the Catholic Church in a variety of ways. Besides their work in the Seminary and School of Theology, monks are serving as chaplains, as faculty at other institutions, and at parishes in several dioceses.

Located in southern Indiana, a mile south of I-64 between exits 72 and 63, Saint Meinrad is about one hour from Evansville. Visitors are always welcome at Saint Meinrad Archabbey.




