



New Brute' Award recipients will be inducted into The Brute' Society during a solemn Ceremony of Induction on Sunday, November 7th, 2021 at Saint Benedict Cathedral.

The following criteria should be used when nominating someone for this award.

NOMINEES MUST:

- 1. Be a parish member in good standing for at least 3 years.
- 2. Reflect the Christian ideal in his/her witness.
- 3. Have participated in, and have been an active member of, a minimum of three functions (committees, events, ministry).
- 4. Represent Christian principles in life outside the parish.

One nomination/name per form.

Nominations must be submitted by July 25th.

👬 Parish Council June Meeting Summary

Synod Planning Process Update: Fr. Jay reported that the parish received the Welborn grant for a Justice Minister but not for the PLC. Fr. Jay has a meeting with the bishop on June 11 to ask if we can proceed with the PLC position. The planning committee is looking at alternative grants for the PLC if needed.

Marketing Committee Report: The new COVID directions from the diocese have been consolidated to one page; a welcoming back letter from Fr. Jay has been sent to all parishioners and a Robo call will follow. The A-Men's Club and the Women's Group will be serving cookies (St. Joseph) and breakfast (St. Anthony) on Family Reunion Weekend. The first veggie giveaway will be July 18; the Praise Mass choir will return to perform from the rectory porch. A group is working on a donor wall (plaque) to honor those who have left bequests to the parish since the 2015 formation of All Saints.

Election of Officers: Council members nominated Gina Tucker (Chair), Fred Mulfinger (Vice-Chair), and Kelly Snyder (Secretary); nominees accepted and were approved as new officers beginning in August 2021.

Other Matters: Deadline for nominations for this year's Bruté Award is August 15. Nominations from the parish will be accepted. The kitchen dishwasher is failing and a replacement is needed. José offered to help with that at a considerable reduction in cost. All Saints plans to add the 5:00 Mass beginning July 18. Fr. Jay reported that the virtual Mass will continue for now. In the future, the parish may live stream the 10:30 Mass to reach those who are not able to return to in-person.

Pastor's Comments: Fr. Jay is hopeful that an implanted heart monitor will indicate that he does not have atrial fib. This would allow him to go off of a blood thinner and hopefully have more strength. The pope has announced a synod and has expanded it to include participation from every diocese. Fr. Jay believes this could be as important to the church as Vatican II. The synod process begins in October. Fr. Jay also expressed a thank you to the four members who are going off the council.


