
Family Faith Formation: Religious Education for families and children is available. Please call Sharon Vogler at the Parish Office.

Nominations for this year's award will be accepted during the months of June/July and submitted to the Parish Council in August. Nomination forms will be placed in both churches. At the August meeting, names of the recipient(s) will be discerned.

New Brute' Award recipients will be inducted into The Brute' Society during a solemn Ceremony of Induction on Sunday, November 7th, 2021 at Saint Benedict Cathedral.

The following criteria should be used when nominating someone for this award.

NOMINEES MUST:

- 1. Be a parish member in good standing for at least 3 years.
- 2. Reflect the Christian ideal in his/her witness.
- 3. Have participated in, and have been an active member of, a minimum of three functions (committees, events, ministry).
- 4. Represent Christian principles in life outside the parish.

Nomination forms are located in the back of both churches, at the Parish Office and on All Saints website, click on the All Saints Parish tab, then choose Forms.

One nomination/name per form.

Nominations must be submitted by July 25th.

Justice Challenge

12th Week in Ordinary Time

Judging is a topic in the readings this week. It is something we all do whether we admit it or not. At a Midwestern parish there was a woman who was in charge of the St. Vincent DePaul chapter and did all the intake of clients who needed assistance. She frequently spoke with the parish staff about clients after they had left the building. She didn't hesitate to express her strong opinions about why this or that person had fallen into poverty. The staff and the pastor suggested that she not be so quick to judge, but to no avail. She really thought she knew people and that it was her right to have and express her opinions. One day, a pregnant woman with three small children came to the office for help. Jeanne remarked to the woman that she obviously couldn't afford the children she had so why another one? The woman bowed her head for a minute and then lifted it and said, "This is my first one actually. The three with me are my sister's children. She and her husband died in a car accident two months ago. We were blessed to be given custody of the children. Of course we weren't prepared for this and I had to guit work to care for them, and we are temporarily in a bind."

The challenge this week is to catch yourself when you are tempted to make a snap judgment before you seek understanding.


