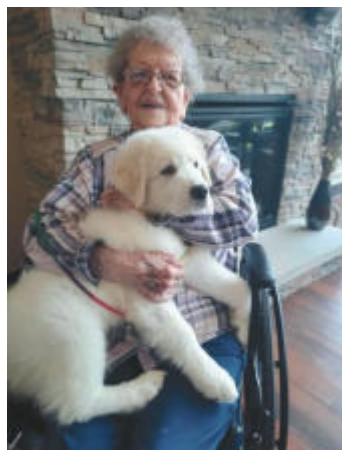

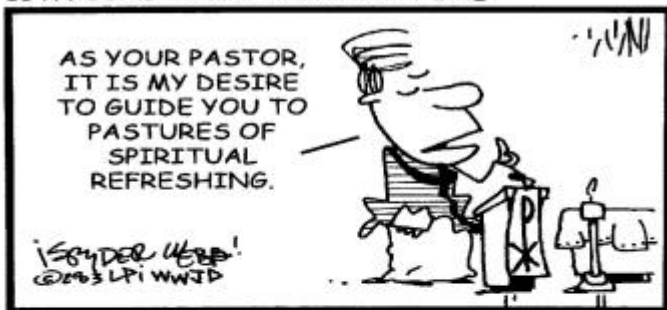
"I received from the Lord what I handed on to you."

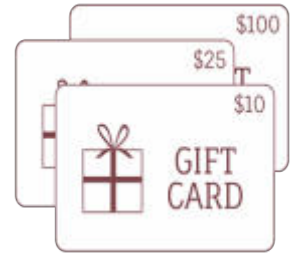

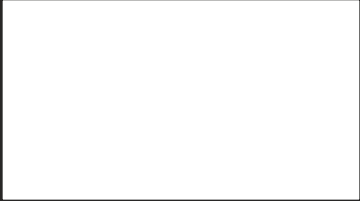
