

Justice Challenge

20th Week in Ordinary Time

There is a lot of talk this week in the readings about how riches keep us from the kingdom of heaven. The rich young man was a good person and yet was asked to give up his riches. He was so challenged that he apparently walked away from the life Jesus was offering. Often people take this Scripture to mean that money is not good. However, Jesus never said that money is bad... it is just our attachment to it and all it can do for us makes it hard to give it up for anything... even eternal life.

Your challenge this week is to take a personal assessment. Go through each room in your house (garage too), and make a list of what you have. Cross out things you really don't need and make plans to give them away. Then go over the list again and see if there are things you can live without. Make plans to give those away too. Encourage the whole family to participate. It is a great way to become less attached to possessions and to remember where they all come from in the first place.
