

#### A Message From CAJE's Lead Organizer: Updates, Urgency, & You!

We are halfway through our annual Listening Process & there have been some amazing & heartbreaking stories shared. The most discussed topics have been...

- Lack of clean, safe, & affordable rental housing
- Deplorable and unhealthy living conditions for those in so-called "affordable" housing: Mold, Pests/Vermin, appliances, furnaces, water heating that don't work or even exist in rental homes
- Worries over high utility bills that are on pace to get even higher
- Folks helping family members pay their utility bills who worry how long they can continue to do so...
- Lack of access to mental health services & concerns about the number of people with a mental health diagnosis currently in our local jails

Unfortunately, there are voices and stories going unheard during our Listening Process. Why is this? House Meetings/Listening Sessions have been canceled or attendance is low (fewer than 8 people present). Our Team Captains and Clergy are scheduled to meet on Zoom Monday, October 18 at 6:15 pm to recap the Listening Process and narrow down the problems that will be presented for vote at the annual Community Problems Assembly, November 15 (6:30 - 8:00 pm). So, what can YOU do? I am glad you asked! If you hosted a House Meeting with fewer than 8 people, please talk to your Organizer about hosting another House Meeting in November or January.

If you have not attended a House Meeting/Listening Session or had to cancel yours, there's a "Second Chance" House Meeting: Sunday October 17, 4:30 - 6 pm on Zoom!

On Monday October 11, 5:30 pm, Evansville City Council will consider (and VOTE) on funding allocations regarding the Affordable Housing Trust Fund (AHTF) City Councilman Zac Heronemus has requested that we bring out the People Power to show our support of MORE funding for the AHTF. Our goal: at least \$2 million allocated into the AHTF.

CAJE staff will arrive at the Civic Center at 5 pm and will provide signs for those who wish to hold them (outside chambers). Signs will reflect the need for safe housing "Fund Housing, Take Down Slum Lords"; "Clean, Safe & Affordable Housing is a Human Right!", etc.

Can't attend? Email the entire City Council at: <u>CityCouncil@evansville.in.gov</u> and ask them to approve/advocate for at least \$2 million - up to \$10 million allocated into the AHTF.
