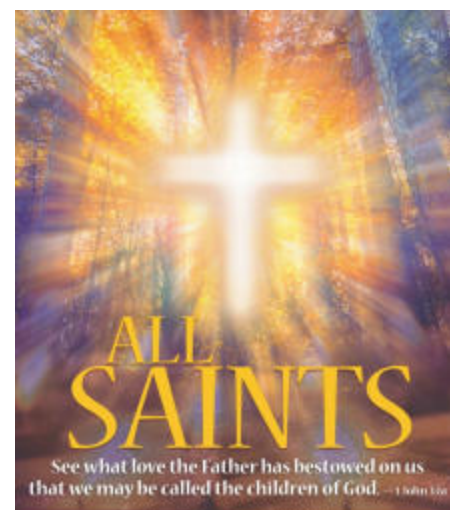
### Thank You for Being So Kind & Generous

## Creation Care News

Many organic gardeners opt for shredding their fall leaves for use in compost piles.

While this is certainly a more environmentally friendly practice than bagging leaves and sending them to the landfill—shredded leaves will not provide the same cover as leaving them whole, and you may be destroying eggs, caterpillars, and chrysalis along with the leaves. We suggest that leaves in garden beds and lawn edges be left whole. Where space allows, consider creating a leaf pile and allowing it to break down naturally, or add the leaves gradually to your compost pile over time. Such efforts will keep critters safe and allow you to benefit from the rich garden gift that falls from the trees above.

Bethel UCC voted in August to officially covenant with CAJE. You may recall that Bethel conducted an exploratory process of about 16 months.

After just one House Meeting (and several 1-1s with our Lead Organizer) Zion Missionary Baptist Church has decided to become a member. Zion, along with Bethel, will officially covenant at the November 15 Community Problems Assembly. Rev. Gerald Arnold, co-founder of CAJE and pastor of Independence Baptist Church has, after a 3.5 year hiatus, informed us of his desire to reactivate Independence as a member of CAJE.

This is encouraging news! More congregations are recognizing the value of joining forces with other faith communities in order to transform our community.

### **CenterPoint Energy Requests to Build Another Power Plant**

CenterPoint Energy Indiana South has filed a petition before the Commission requesting the issuance of a CPCN for the construction of two combined cycle gas turbine generation facilities and other related cost recovery.

During field hearings, ratepayers have the opportunity to speak directly to the Commission or submit written comments. Please note, though, that because this is a pending case, the Commissioners and Judge are not allowed to answer questions or engage in any discussion about the case.
