Family Faith Formation: Religious Education for families and children is available. Please call Sharon Vogler at the Parish Office.






The Automated External Defibrillators are located in the back of St. Anthony Church near the restroom and the front west wall in St. Joseph Church.

Justice Challenge

Solemnity of our Lord Jesus Christ, King of the Universe

This month is the anniversary of Dorothy Day's death. Dorothy Day, co-founder of the Catholic Worker movement in the U.S., was known for her deep care and compassion for the poor. She called those who had nothing left to give her "meeting place with God." But she did more than acts of charity—she became an advocate for those who are denied basic human. rights. Your challenge this week is to search your heart and ask yourself, "Do I work for justice as well as care for those in need?" Then choose one act of justice—emailing your legislators about a vote coming up in Congress on aid to the poor, calling the White House to let the President know your opinion on a justice issue, researching the just (or unjust) practices of a company from which you purchase goods and then choosing how much you can or cannot support that company—and follow in Dorothy Day's footsteps. Do something for those who have nothing to give you in return.

If you itemize your deductions The Adjusted Gross Income limitation for charitable contributions is 100%. You can deduct your cash or cash-equivalent contributions from your entire income.

If you don't itemize your deductions

You are able to claim a charitable deduction of up to \$300 if filing on your own, or up to \$600 if filing jointly with your spouse.

IRA charitable donations

You may be able to avoid paying tax by making a charitable distribution straight from your account to All Saints Parish. It's easy to do! Just notify the custodian of your IRA.

When you think of what these pollinators need, visualize natural areas where they have

evolved. Natural areas are not manicured, sticks and leaves are not "cleaned up" and removed, grasses grow long, seed heads are left for songbirds to feed on, and seeds can fall where they might germinate. Now visualize your yard. Do you have any of the messiness of the local natural area? If not, you are likely not providing for all of the important animals that help pollinate your plants, provide pest control in your garden, and help build healthy soils. But for many people there is no way that they are going to give over their entire yards just to nature. After all, most yards are designed for humans—not nature. But you can provide both a great place to live, to entertain and for kids to play and provide vital winter habitat for the bees, butterflies, birds, and other wildlife that also need homes.




