Pope Francis and the Joy of the Gospel

Since his election, Pope Francis has been guiding and nudging our Church to rise up to meet the challenges of our era. The foundation of his vision can be found in his first encyclical, "The Joy of the Gospel". Tom Bogenschutz has taught and lead several discussions on this document and recently produced a video that summarizes the Pope's encyclical. It is 30 minutes in length and offers an overview of the Pope and his dream for the Church. 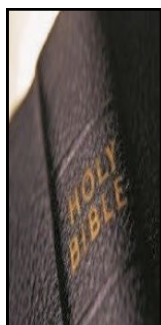
Wednesday Morning Bible Study

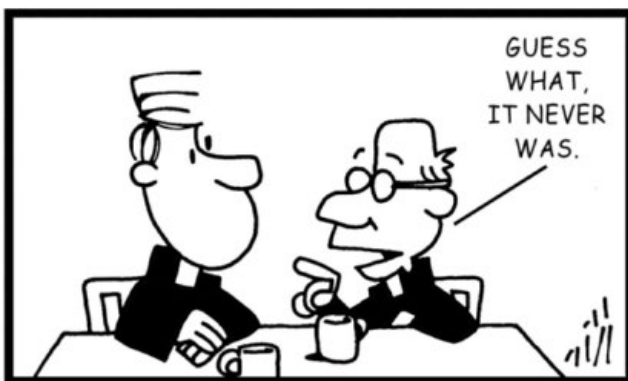
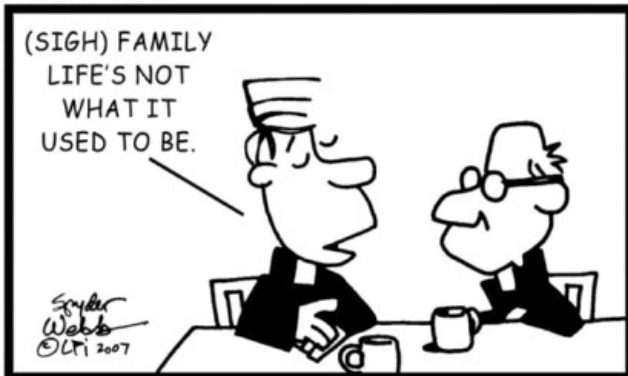

Qualified Charitable Distributions to All Saints Parish

If you are over 70 ½, consider making charitable donations from your IRA using a Qualified Charitable Distribution (QCD). You can transfer up to \$100,000 per year to an eligible charity. This would be a great way to grow the parish endowments, help with a special project, or pay your weekly giving in one lump sum. While a QCD does not generate a charitable deduction, you do not have to report the income. This is a great option for people to still get a tax benefit even though they are not able to itemize deductions.

Charitable deduction rules can be very complicated, and you should work with your tax advisor to ensure you are maximizing the tax benefit of any donation.
