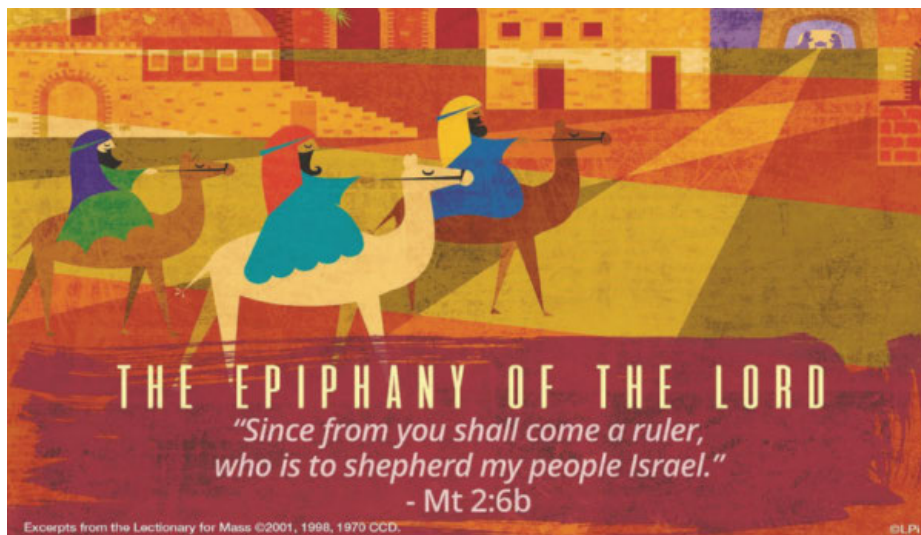

EPIPHANY BLESSING OF OUR HOME



LEADER: May God's peace be in our homes.

ALL: And in all who enter here.

LEADER: Wise men came from the East to pay homage to the Lord, and opening their treasures, they offered precious gifts.

ALL: Gold for his kingship, incense to proclaim him God, and myrrh for the day of his burial.

LEADER: All from Sheba shall come.

ALL: Bearing gold and frankincense.

LEADER: O Lord, hear our prayer.

ALL: And let our cry come to you.

LEADER: Let us pray.

Father, you revealed your Son to the nations by the guidance of a star. Lead us to your glory and our eternal home by the light of faith in Jesus Christ our Lord.

ALL: Amen.

With chalk, crayon, or written on a piece of paper affixed to top of the doorway, an inscription is made above the door.

20 + C + M + B + 22

The letters represent the Magi. The enclosing year represents the timeless God.

Each cross marks a point of the compass or "all the nations."

LEADER: Arise! Shine! Jerusalem, your light has come.

ALL: And our God is with us.

LEADER: Lord, Almighty God, bless this home.

Let here live health and goodness, humility and faith, and every triumph over sin.

Let your Word be obeyed and fulfilled here, and thanksgiving ever be made to you,

Father, Son, and Holy Spirit, now and forever. Amen.

Questions of the Week

First Reading:

The prophet Isaiah foresaw a time of great joy for Israel when nations and kings would come to Israel praising the Lord. How do you show gratitude to the Lord for the great joys of your life?

Second Reading:

It was revealed to Paul that God intended to save all people (Jews and Gentiles) through his Son, Jesus Christ. Paul tried to convey the significance of this revelation to the Ephesians by using the language of "coheirs" and "copartners." What does this language signal to you?

Gospel:

The visit of the magi is one of the most well-known stories from the Gospel infancy narratives. It was an event that manifested God's revelation of His newborn Son to the world. It also foreshadowed the threat that some would experience because of Jesus. How does Jesus challenge the status quo even today?

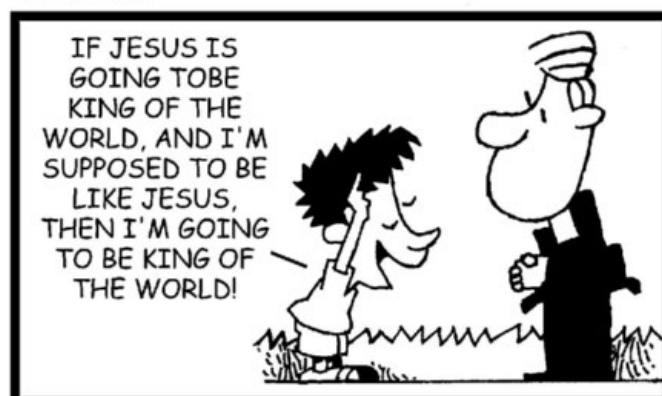
Justice Challenge

Epiphany

We celebrate the Epiphany of the Lord this week. This feast reminds us that Jesus was a universal savior—for all people, not just the Jews. The Magi who brought special gifts to the infant Jesus came from distant lands. They recognized the Messiah in the tiny baby more than most of Jesus' own people did. Sometimes it's easy to forget that our Catholic faith is open to everyone. But the word "catholic" means universal—for everyone, everywhere, all the time. **Your challenge this week** is to give a special gift to someone who has been left out, someone who hasn't been invited into the inner circle of friendship, someone who really needs an unexpected gift. It might be something material, but it could also be the gift of conversation, listening, paying attention.

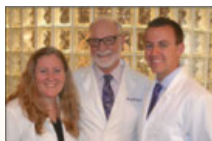

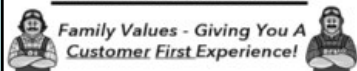
