This will be a hybrid meeting so anyone can join from home with the Zoom link. Postcards have been created and will be sent out to Parishioners when a date is set.

We continue our search for a Justice Minster and Parish Life Coordinator.

Pastor's Comments:

Evansville Mayor proposed \$64.4 million for several programs, including CAJE programs for mental health, autism, diversion center and affordable health care funding.

We continue to review the need for the Recorded Mass. Views continue to decline. Discussion of what can we do about the high cost of utility bills, possible meeting with Center Point Officials and Legislators from the area at a future date?

Next Month's Meeting: Tuesday, April 5, 2022, at 6:00 p.m. This meeting is scheduled to be hybrid.


