Meeting began at 6:00 p.m. with prayer led by Don Kuhr. February Minutes: approved as written. Commission Reports were reviewed. Dates for our Synod gathering were discussed. Dates will be sent to Father Alex Zenthoefer for final decision. At this time, the Synod will be held in the cafeteria on our St. Anthony Church campus. This will be a hybrid meeting so anyone can join from home with the Zoom link. Postcards have been created and will be sent out to Parishioners when a date is set.

We continue our search for a Justice Minister and Parish Life Coordinator.

Facilities:

Boilers have been installed and are working well. AC is currently being installed in the Rectory. Carpet installation has been completed at St. Joseph Church.

Discussions on Other Matters:

Prayer Service could be held for the Ukraine? Ash Wednesday collection is designated for the Churches of Eastern Europe (this has always included the Ukraine). Announcement to this end will be made at Ash Wednesday Masses.

If there is money left in the parish's We Care Fund, could it be used to help parishioners with utility bills?

Children's Choir is doing a great job!

2 humidifier/dehumidifiers are being purchased for the 2 pianos (St. Joseph Church and St. Anthony Church).

Pastor's Comments:

Evansville Mayor proposed \$64.4 million for several programs, including CAJE programs for mental health, autism, diversion center and affordable health care funding.

We continue to review the need for the Recorded Mass. Views continue to decline. Discussion of what can we do about the high cost of utility bills, possible meeting with Center Point Officials and Legislators from the area at a future date?

Next Month's Meeting: Tuesday, April 5, 2022, at 6:00 p.m. This meeting is scheduled to be hybrid.

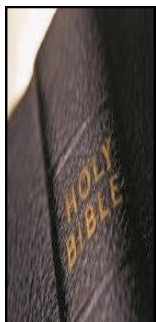

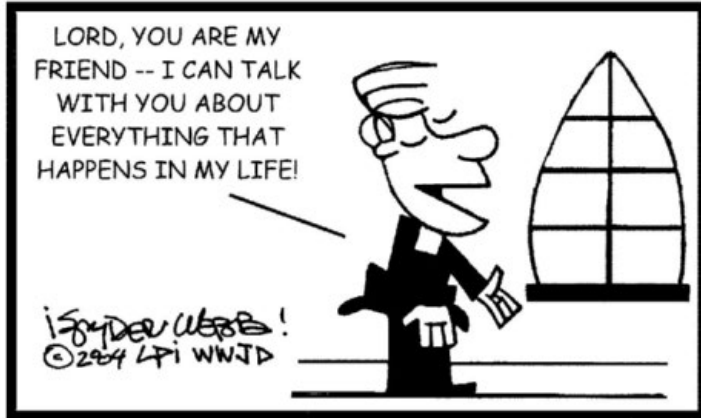

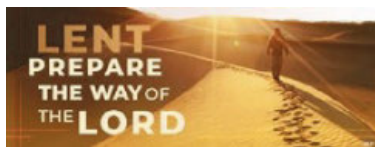
