All Saints Health Ministry Offering Daily Devotions for Lent "Walking (Movement) to the Cross"



Walking (Movement) to the Cross is a devotional program designed for the season of Lent. The program is for people of all ages and health conditions. It offers opportunity to reflect on our own sacrificial service to God and others. God asks us to care for what He cares for. Begins March 13, four weeks of goal setting, scripture, prayer and increased movement.

This self-directed program offers:

- Setting a weekly "movement goal" or a reasonable physical challenge for yourself.
- Movement chosen to meet your needs may be walking or stretching or exercise.
- A weekly goal, daily passage of Scripture along with a thought and a prayer.
- Read any time of the day, or reflect during your chosen activity (movement).
- Weekly check in to see the progress of all participants or answer questions.

Justice Challenge

1st Sunday in Lent

This Sunday's Gospel describes Jesus' temptation in the desert. Jesus was tempted with three things: satisfying the flesh by breaking his fast and eating the bread; becoming instantly famous by performing a super-hero act; and seizing power by making a pack with the devil. Jesus rejected all three temptations.

Your challenge this week is to examine your own life to determine the temptations which the devil is placing in front of you. What do you need to say no to? What are you tempted to do which would cause others' lives to be lessened if you indulged in it?
