Rite of Christian Initiation for Adults (RCIA): Those wishing to become Catholic or learn more about the Catholic faith may call the Parish Office.


Justice Challenge

Gabriel Project

The Gabriel Project is a pro-life ministry that provides material, personal, and spiritual support to pregnant women and young families in

need. The project started in Texas in 1973; many chapters have formed since then including St. John's Parish in Daylight Indiana; they have been serving since 2008.

By their witness, we are hoping to extend the spirit of the Gabriel Project to the west side of Evansville. Once a month we will be visiting families; praying with them, visiting with them, and providing material support based on their needs.

The needs of each family will vary month to month, be we are mainly looking to provide diapers, wipes, household supplies, and gift cards to ease monthly expenses; an estimate of about \$100.00 per month, per family.

To help us with this mission, we are having a Diaper and Wipes Drive. You can purchase diapers (sizes 2T and up) and wipes and drop them off at the All Saints Parish Office. If you would prefer to make a monetary donation, please leave your donation in the baby bottle labeled "Gabriel Project." Thank you for your support and please pray for this ministry!
