

## Justice Challenge 1st Week of Advent

The first reading for this Sunday is one with which we are familiar. It is the passage from the Book of Isaiah (2:1-5) describing what the world will be like when the Messiah comes. The image of people beating swords into plowshares-taking instruments used to kill people and changing them into instruments which help grow food to feed people—is a powerful one. Your challenge in this first week of Advent is to spend some time reflecting on how you are peacemakers (as a family and as individuals). Do you bring people together by your words and actions or do you create conflict? Then decide on one action you can take to make the world a more peace-filled place. Do you want to pray for peace in our world, our country, and our families? Do you want to write to government leaders to advocate for a more peaceful approach to a particular issue? Do you want to take a stand for more gun control? How do you want to bring peace?

CAJE Network members who want to work on finding proven solutions commit to working on a particular CAJE issue campaign. Each issue group sets up meetings to further study the problem, talk with key individuals and learn how other communities have addressed similar issues.

Research starts in December and continues thru January and February. Each problem issue is directed by a steering committee and has a larger committee represented by all the congregations.

Starting in March, these groups are responsible for cutting the issues and developing the questions that will be presented to key individuals who have the power to implement these community changes.

"This is my body given for you." (Luke 22:19) **...Awesome God** People reaching for God and God reaching for people. We can't get there on our own.

Responsorial Psalm - Let us go rejoicing to the house of the Lord.

Gospel - Therefore, stay awake! For you do not know on which day your Lord will come.

These three passages make me reflect on how I bring myself to Mass on the weekend. Have I prepared for Mass? Do I come rejoicing knowing that I will hear the Word of God, receive Christ's body, celebrate with the Body of Christ present at Mass? And how do I leave this celebration renewed and strengthened for the coming week until we gather again?




