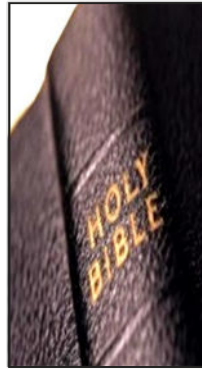

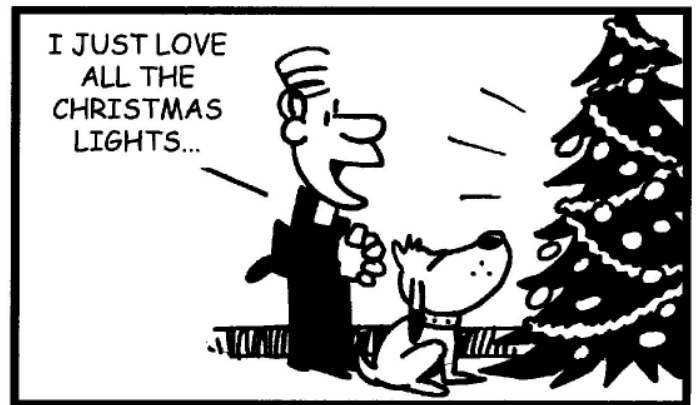
People reaching for God and God reaching for people.

From the homilies recently...

Fr. Steve

Gaudete Sunday....expectations.
What are we expecting for Christmas?

John had many expectations. From prison, he told his disciples to see if Jesus was the real Messiah. John may have been looking for a powerful Messiah. What are our expectations of God?

To grow the church, we have to make a difference in other peoples lives. We need to invite people to come to church with us at Christmas.

Lenny wanted a pony. If I have a pony I don't want anything else. On Christmas morning, his sisters had big presents. He didn't have a pony. He cried. He went to the stable - no pony. He sobbed. There was a man walking down the road with a pony, but he didn't stop at his house. He cried again. The man asked him, friend do you know where Lenny lives? I have his pony.

We all have expectations, but God's time is not always our time. We are told to wait patiently. We must continue to dream.

We have expectations of what it means to be disciples. God expects a lot of us.....always to help people.

Today we are called to think about change. John the Baptist called people to repent and change. Apparently John had some changing to do, too. He sent his disciples to Jesus to see if Jesus was the real Messiah. John expected the Messiah to be a warrior king. John had to change his thinking.

Sometimes in life, we have to change our thinking. Pope Francis is asking us to think about our religion and our beliefs. Do we need to grow? Do we need to expand? Do we need to evolve?

We have to pray, and discern about what we need to change and when. Are we ready now? Will we be will be ready later? It's going to be an interesting struggle to think about changing the way we think, the way we pray, and the way we believe. Am I open to the possibility to believe that maybe I should think about things differently in the future?

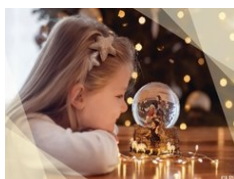

We are offering a small group program called **Want to Talk? Communication Tools for Divided Times**.



I'm Brenda Meyer, Justice Minister at All Saints Parish. I'm co-facilitating this program because I've been looking for healthier ways to navigate disagreement in my family and social circle. Especially given the polarization we're experiencing right now, I want to learn how to have tough conversations around justice issues I care about with people who think differently than I do. Would you be interested in joining me?

Want to Talk consists of eight two-hour sessions plus an "immersion experience," in which we'll practice our new communication skills in real life. During each regular session, we'll pray together, discuss books, watch videos, and have conversations around how we can deepen our relationships while staying true to our values. 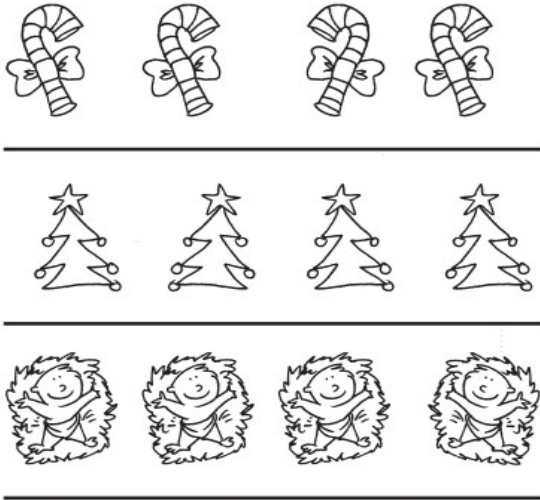
