



I'm Brenda Meyer, Justice Minister at All Saints Parish. I'm co-facilitating this program because I've been looking for healthier ways to navigate disagreement in my family and social circle. Especially given the polarization we're experiencing right now, I want to learn how to have tough conversations around justice issues I care about with people who think differently than I do. Want to Talk consists of eight two-hour sessions plus an "immersion experience," in which we'll practice our new communication skills in real life.
