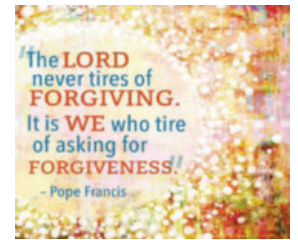

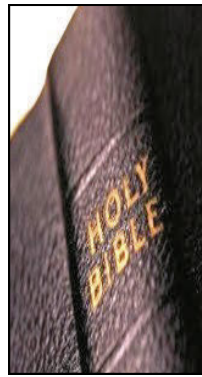

Keynote: Hearing the Cry of the Earth, in the Din of the Day-to-Day
By John Mundell, Global Director of the Laudato Si" Action Platform

This year, we also will highlight Ray Wilson of Faith in Place who will present on, "Thriving Faith Communities, How to Save Energy and Money." By focusing on their use of energy and even the installation of solar, faith communities can save significant dollars. Those attending Ray's breakout session will learn the basics and receive tips on energy conservation and see how other how other congregations have succeeded in energy savings as well as becoming more earth friendly.

Justice Challenge 6th Sunday in Ordinary Time

The Gospel for Sunday is part of the Sermon on the Mount. Jesus is focusing on keeping the commandments. He emphasizes that the Fifth Commandment, "Thou shalt not kill," means more than not taking someone's life. It also means not being angry or destroying someone's self-esteem by calling them names. **Your challenge this week** is to look at your life and examine where you might have hurt someone—physically, emotionally through negative gossip, cyber criticism, or derogatory words, or even spiritually by giving bad example. Make a commitment to changing that hurtful behavior, say a prayer for the person you have hurt, and try to have the courage to ask forgiveness in person.

OR

On Valentine's Day we send or bring flowers or candy, jewelry or cards, to people whom we love. **Your challenge this week** is to look at those who don't have loving people in their lives, those who experience a poverty of spirit if not economic poverty. This might include the person in your life who most annoys you; it might be someone next door who yells if you walk on their grass; it could be a shut-in; it might even be a person in Isis who is hated or feared across the world for fostering war or violence. Pray for this person if he or she is far away. If the person lives close by, do one act of loving kindness for him/her (e.g., just hold a conversation, or drop off homemade cookies, or bring the person flowers or a handmade card).

We've heard this many times.

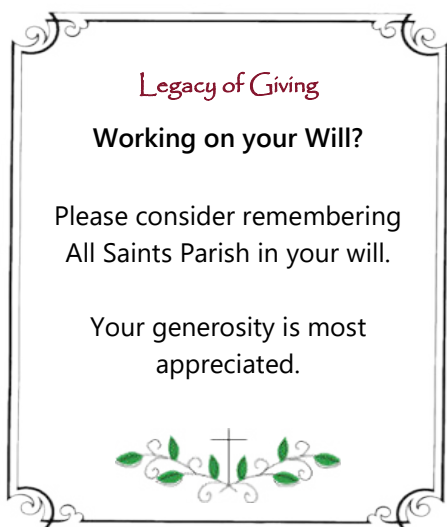
In Jesus' day when they cooked, they had a community oven for the whole village to use. What did they use for fuel? There wasn't much wood. Someone discovered that camel and donkey dung would burn if you mixed salt into it. It became the task of young girls to collect dung, mix salt in, make it into patties and put it in the sun to dry. In the oven they would put a layer of salt and then the dung. This is how they did most of their cooking.

You are the salt of the earth. Should we be mixed into the dung of the world and cause it to burn?

In John's gospel, Jesus says, "I am the light of the world." In Matthew's gospel, "You are the salt and light." It is your responsibility to be light.

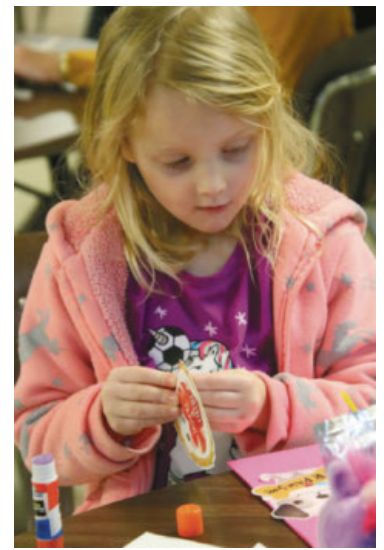

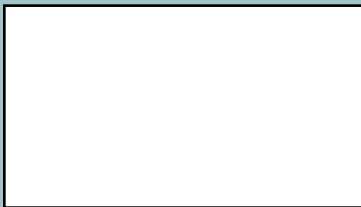
