### Justice Challenge 7th Sunday in Ordinary Time

This Sunday's Gospel challenges us to think differently about revenge and about hating our enemies. While the Old Testament supports the death penalty, it is clear that Jesus is advocating for a different approach when he tells us to turn the other cheek and to love our enemies. Your challenge this week is to google Bud Welch, whose daughter was killed by Timothy McVeigh in the bombing of the Federal Building in Oklahoma City. Read about Bud's view of the death penalty and of his daughter's killer, then examine your own stance and ask God for guidance on where you are called to stand on this controversial issue. Ask the Spirit to be with you as you strive to live out Jesus' teaching about meeting violence with nonviolence.

It is an em-blem of Christ's abiding love and a reminder to the faith-ful to respond with loving adoration in return. In Judaism, the sanctuary lamp is known by its Hebrew name, Ner Tamid (Hebrew: "eternal flame"). Hanging or standing in front of the "ark" in every Jewish synagogue Jewish synagogue where the sacred scrolls are kept. It also symbolizes God's eternal presence and is therefore never extinguished. In a sense, the Sanctuary Lamp can be likened to the "beating heart" of every church.


