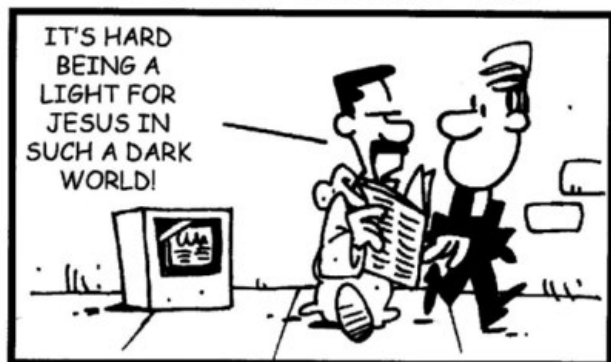
## Justice Challenge 5th Sunday in Ordinary Time

Somehow this Gospel is huge as I get older. Many people demand that the 10 Commandments be posted in public.

I have never seen the Beatitudes posted. These are the words of Jesus. They are not a to do list like the Commandments. They are about living. Jesus is not telling us what to do but how to live.
