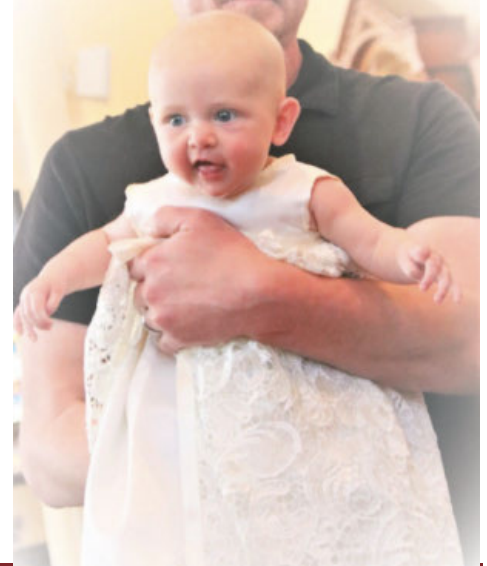

Justice Challenge 2nd Sunday of Easter

Sunday's Gospel recounts the appearance of Jesus to the apostles after the Resurrection. Fear ruled the day until Jesus came back with his message, "Peace be with you." Fear can paralyze us, just as it did the apostles until Jesus breathed his Spirit and his peace into them. **Your challenge this week** is to examine how much fear rules your life. When does it stop you from speaking the prophetic word, challenging injustice, or living an ethical life? Pray for the peace of Christ to enter your own heart, and find the courage to fight injustice wherever you see it.

OR

Justice Challenge: Earth Day occurs on April 22. We recently commemorated the suffering and death of Jesus, the day on which he paid the ultimate sacrifice to redeem us. But we also remember that his death led to new life. **Your challenge this week** is to think of how you can care for God's creation as a way of thanking God for the sacrifice which Jesus made out of love for us. What can you do to take care of our earth? What can you do to ensure that you leave the earth a little bit greener for future generations?

"This is my body given for you."

(Luke 22:19) ...**Awesome God** People reaching for God and God reaching for people. We can't get there on our own.

In this Easter season, we are remembering our encounters with Jesus. We have six First Communicants who will be celebrating the sacraments of Reconciliation and Eucharist in the next couple of weeks. I have no memories of my First Communion. There are pictures to help me remember the celebration.

It is the 3,000 plus times I've received the Eucharist since my First Communion that I am called to reflect on. What does it mean to me, to us, to receive the Body of Christ? What are we thinking about as we walk up the aisle with our parish community to receive the Eucharist? Are we focused on what we are about to receive or are we distracted? Personally, I can be easily distracted.

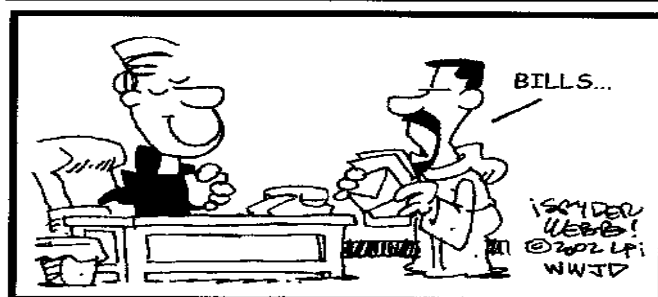
A couple of my favorite personal reflections on the Eucharist are during the Eucharistic prayer when the Body and Blood are presented, and we are invited to take and eat and drink. My silent prayer is "My Lord, and My God. O Sacrament most holy O Sacrament divine, all praise and all thanksgiving be every moment Thine." After I have received the Eucharist, I pray silently, "Thank you God for the gift of yourself. May this communion strengthen me to do your will."

Nominees must be...

- at least 18 years of age
- have been a member of All Saints Parish for at least two years
- active members (regularly come to Church for Mass and share their time, talent & treasure with All Saints Parish)
- Catholic
- able to attend meetings.

Submit nominations/names along with the gifts/strengths you see in the person(s). Nominations are kept anonymous. Nominations can put in the box at church, be emailed to Sharon at svogler@evdio.org, or given to Sharon at Mass.

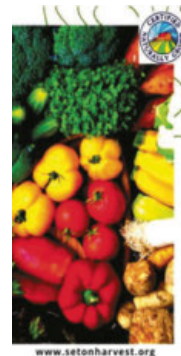
