

"This is my body given for you."

(Luke 22:19) ... Awesome God People reaching for God and God reaching for people. We can't get there on our own.



**Knowledge** is the gift of knowing and enlightenment. The gift of knowledge enables you to choose the right path that will lead you to God. It encourages you to avoid obstacles that will keep you from him.

**Courage, or Fortitude**, is the gift that helps you stand up for your faith in Christ. The gift of courage helps you overcome any obstacles that would keep you from practicing your faith.

**Understanding** is the gift of comprehension, or the ability to grasp the meaning of the teachings of the Church. The gift of understanding helps you be tolerant and sympathetic of others. It helps you sense when someone is hurting or in need of compassion.

**Reverence or Piety**, is the gift of confidence in God. This gift of reverence inspires you to joyfully want to serve God and others.

**Wisdom** is the gift of knowing the right choices to make to live a holy life. The gift of wisdom helps you to avoid the things that could lead you away from God.

**Right Judgment or Counsel**, is the gift of prudence. The gift of right judgment helps you make choices to live as a faithful follower of Jesus.

Wonder and Awe or Fear of the Lord is the gift of wonder and respect that encourages you to be in awe of God. The gift of wonder and awe moves you to so love God that you do not want to offend him by your words or actions.

Bob formed World Vision to provide services to people living in poverty around the world.

Go therefore, make disciples of all nations teaching them to obey everything that I have commanded you. Know that I am with you always until the end of the age.

Jesus could have not worried about us human beings. He could have converted the world by himself teaching people to love one another. He didn't do that. He gave us the power and the paths to carry on his mission for him. He would be there through the Spirit, and we are to do the work. This is the task Jesus calls us to follow.

Jesus gave us the task to love one another. He told us we love one another by loving God. He meant everybody, all people, the unlovable, people we can't stand. You don't have to be in love with them, but you have to love them as God loves them. I tend to think if all Christians took that seriously, we would convert the world in no time. People would see how we love one another, and they would join us or hate us. The world would change. We are called to show God's love. People think they can't do that.

The real hero in Bob's story is the teacher who planted the seeds. She changed his life and the world. Can we do that much? Jesus calls us to follow him, to spread his love. He is waiting to see what happens. How are we seriously loving one another, all people and spreading that love to others?

#### Justice Challenge Pentecost

Pentecost is often called the birthday of the Church. It is a celebration of the day the Holy Spirit came upon the disciples and believers in the upper room after the Resurrection. Each person was given gifts to use to share the good news of Jesus with the world. One of the first challenges the early Church faced was finding the time to distribute food to the hungry. The apostles saw this action as a priority, but their preaching and teaching were taking time from helping the poor. So they appointed special deacons whose task was specifically to serve the poor. Your challenge this week is to look around and see a human need in your parish family which your pastor does not have the time to address. How can you serve someone in distress—physically, emotionally or spiritually? What can you do to help?
