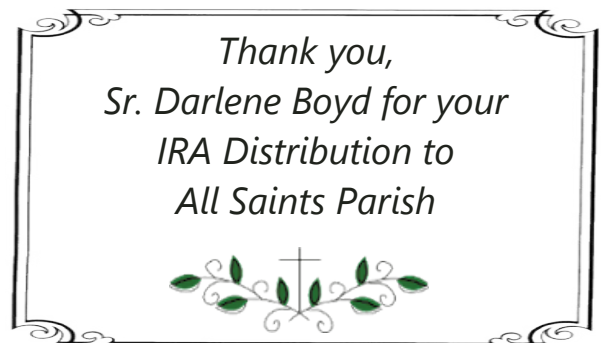

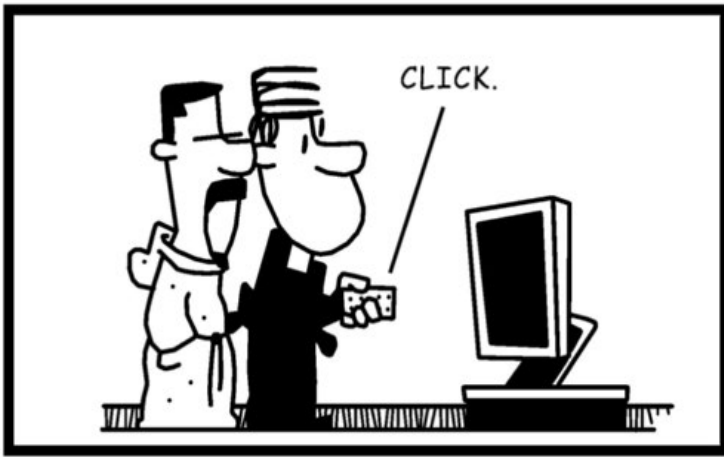

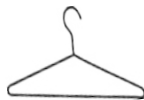

Volunteer at the Congress

The 10th National Eucharistic Congress has been an incredible collaborative effort from the start. Over 200 Catholic organizations and apostolates have stepped up to be a part of this moment in various ways, but **we need individual Catholics to help out too!** The rebirth of this incredible legacy can only happen if we all pitch in.

Whether you are already registered to attend the National Eucharistic Congress or you’re still finalizing your plans, **you are invited to join our volunteer team!**

Being a volunteer comes with perks:

Full-time volunteers get free lunch and dinner each day of the event and have access to discounted hotel rates. When not on duty, Volunteer Staff will be able to access and attend available Congress sessions for FREE (they do not need to purchase a Congress Pass). Some roles will experience more programming than others.

Shift volunteers play a part-time role. These can be Day Pass holders who want to attend some days of the Congress and serve on other days, Full Event Pass holders who want to serve for a few hours while at the event, or individuals without a pass who still want to be a part of the Congress in some way. From the homilies recently...

Fr. Tom

The feast of Corpus Christi goes back to the 13th century. We believe that somehow God became one of us, the incarnation. God became flesh. We believe that God's eternal word comes through Jesus. So we believe in the real presence of a God through Jesus.

In the 13th century, people thought they weren't worthy enough to go to communion. So the church said you have to go at least once a year. People were wanting to simply adore Jesus. The church had to do something with all of that, so they made rules and regulations.

What I believe is that we have to get God out of our heads and out of religion books, and out of our creed and dogmas so he becomes real and affects us. That's what this altar, table of the Lord, is all about. This is the Lord's table. I don't invite you to come here. It is the Lord who invites us to come together. It is impossible to be a Christian by yourself. I have been at altars for 49 years. I am still learning what altars are all about.

We participate in the Lord's Eucharistic table. Since the first century through 2024, people who do not know each other come together and receive together. This is an absolute blessing that we can do this. Next to the blessed sacrament, our neighbor is the most blessed to us.

The Eucharist is not just something that we do. It is that we welcome people. We visit the sick. We shelter the poor. We work for human rights. We work to protect the unborn and all life. We do that because we are people who worship an incarnate God, Jesus... The body and blood of Christ. The body and blood of Christ is our task.

Fr. Steve

One of my favorite things every year, is to celebrate the Seder Supper...the Passover.

The ritual is filled with life. Today we celebrate that feast of the most holy body and blood of Christ.

I think the message Jesus would give us is that God is always active in our lives. God is always taking the initiative. God draws us to the Word of God and to take and eat of my body. Take and drink of my blood. God's gifts come to us in the bread of life and in the cup of salvation. God calls us all to be in communion with one another, and union.

God is very active in our life. We are called to respond...to come to the table. We are the body and blood of Christ to one another.
